

Do you think that the curriculum which you had during your graduation/post graduation has provided you with the knowledge & skills necessa...et employed/Self-employed or start own business?








Industry Expert Feedback Analysis on Curriculum (2020-21)




Do you feel that the present syllabus will enhance interpersonal skills of the students? To what 41 responses













Does the curriculum offer you a choice to study as per your interest?














