Sir,

I am directed to refer to your letter No. Aff/Recog/21104 of 1984 dated 20.2.84 on the subject mentioned above and to convey approval of the State Government under section 43(4) of the Bombay University Act 1974 for further processing by the University the applications for continuation/Extension of affiliation of colleges, from the academic year 1984, mentioned in appended statement for the courses/subjects mentioned against each of them.

2. Necessary further action for processing the applications under section 43 (5) of the Act may be taken and the proposal under section 43(6 & 7) be forwarded to Government for final orders.

3. While sending the proposal under section 43(6 & 7) in case of continuation on permanent basis, it should specifically be mentioned as to whether the college fulfills the conditions mentioned in section 45 of the University Act. As regards the proposal for starting of altogether new subjects Government's initial approval is subject to the condition that the minimum students strength per class per subject must be 15 in corporation area and 5/other places. As regarding permanent affiliation University may satisfy itself whether the colleges fulfill the requisite conditions.
