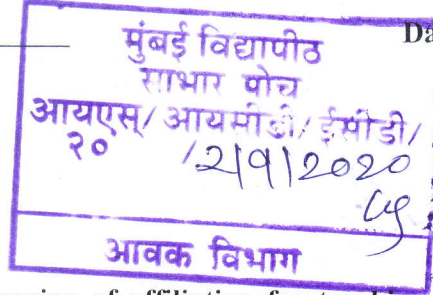

Sir,

In continuation of this office letter No.PG/2/ 2365 dated 07th July, 2005, requesting permission to start M.A. degree course (by papers) in the subject of Psychology from the academic year 2005-2006, I am directed to inform you that on the Recommendation of the Board of University Teaching and Research in the faculty of Arts (vide item No.2 / 26th May, 2006) the Academic Council at its meeting held on 07th June, 2006 vide item No.8.1 accepted the report of the Local Inquiry Committee appointed for the purpose and in accordance therewith K.V. Pendharkar College of Arts ,Science and Commerce , Thane has been granted extension of affiliation to start M.A. degree course (by Papers) in the subject of Psychology from the academic year 2005-2006 for a period of 3 years subject to the fulfillment of following conditions :-

1. Books for study : Sufficient number of original textbooks and reference books recommended by the Board of the Studies in Psychology in the prescribed syllabus should be purchase and made available in the library.
2. Use of Appropriate Teaching Methodology : At the Postgraduate level , the teaching methodology should be such so as to intellectually stimulate the students as well as to involve them in solving the practical Psychological issues encountered by them in their environment . Hence, to achieve these goals, a more participative and stimulating teaching methodology should be used, to orient the students towards practical problem solving. This is especially recommended for subjects like Research Methodology and Statistics.
3. Experiments & Testing in Psychology Practicals: The college should immediately purchase all the required Psychological tests from the authorized test distributors, and students must not use photocopies of the tests. In case of D.A.T., the full battery should be used, as is recommended in the syllabus.
4. Timetable : The timetable provided to the Committee by the College was a handwritten one, with only dates, timing and names of the Professor.) A proper timetable containing all the details like- the topics and the papers to be covered and the number of hours in a week by each Lecturer/ Reader / Professor, and the number of hours of Practical should be immediately prepared, type and signed by the head of the department of Psychology.
5. Signature of the Practical teacher –supervisor : The journal maintained by the students for Practicals conducted by them did not carry the signature of the Practical teacher –supervisor. After every practical, the concerned Supervisor must sign the report of that practical immediately.
6. Statutory Number of Hours / Days to be completed : Though the government letter to start the course was received by the college on the 28th of June 2005, the M.A. part I course started from 1st September, 2005. The college authorities should see to it that the number of hours / days as required by the University rules are completed and adhered to .
7. National / International Journals : The College subscribes to three Indian Journals, out of which only two are indexed. The college does not subscribe to any international journal. The College should immediately subscribe to a few international journals, like -

8. It is recommended that the college should adhere to the rules of University of Mumbai concerning the required qualifications of faculty employed to carry out Postgraduate teaching.
 9. Teaching Assistants should not be given the entire responsibility of a Full Paper . It is recommended that the assistants should only assist the faculty, and should not be in charge of a full paper.
 10. Separate section in the Library : The College should immediately set up separate section for the Postgraduate students in Psychology and must increase the number of books-both texts as well as reference.
 11. Computer and Internet facility : A Separate Computer and Internet facility needs to be immediately set up in the department to coordinate with the external agencies for the placement of the students and better interaction with the community.
 12. Separate Laboratory for Postgraduate students: It was observed that the laboratory facility was provided in the morning for the Undergraduate students, and in the afternoon for the Postgraduate students, it is desirable to have separate laboratory and separate set up only for the P.G. students so that they can have freedom to study and interact for longer periods of time.
 13. The placements of students for fieldwork in counseling in M.A. Part II in the year 2006-07 should be carefully planned, as per the ethical and academic norms.
 14. The following books – as many as possible should be immediately purchased for the library and made available to the students.
