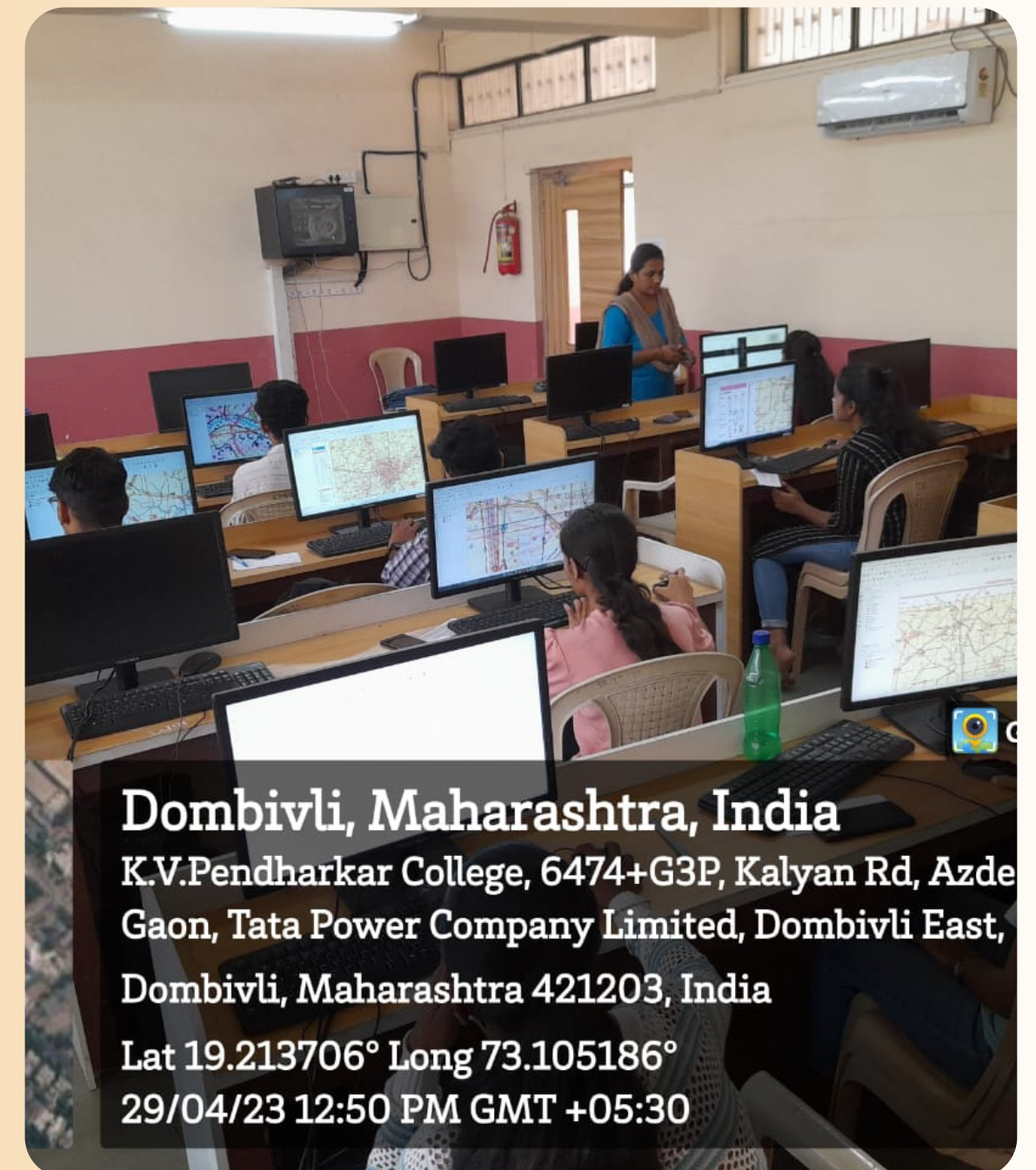

Exploring the nature of Drastic Change in Bhiwandi City



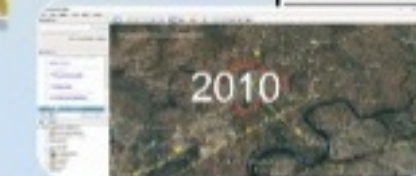
