

REPORT ON RAGGING AWARENESS PROGRAMME

Many students in the world and India have been committing suicides after undergoing barbaric episodes of ragging. So also, many students' careers have been jeopardized after both perpetrating and facing ragging. Hence, the Anti-Ragging Committee of our college organized a **“Ragging Awareness Programme”** on Monday, 22nd August, 2016. The main objective of this programme was to create awareness among the first year degree college students about ragging-prohibition, prevention and punishment. In the programme, a lecture was delivered and an animation film based on ragging was screened. A video tape (total length: 10 minutes and 53 seconds) was also screened to enable students to understand the gravity of ragging, and the nature of punishment to offenders as per the Maharashtra Prevention of Ragging ACT, 1999 and Notification issued by UGC dated 17th June, 2009. The procedure of how to lodge a complaint against the offender by the victim of ragging was also discussed. In all, 15 teachers of all faculties (Aided-Unaided, Science-Commerce-Arts) along with 982 students of first year actively participated in this programme. Many students freely asked questions and their doubts were resolved.

The same programme was also organised for the first year students of the Junior college under the guidance of Mrs Mansi Kale-Vice Principal of Junior College on Wednesday, 24th August, 2016 from 10.30am to 5.30pm. All the classes of first year of Science, Arts and Commerce were visited by the committee to orient the students. As many as 13 teachers of Junior college along with 589 students participated in this programme.

This programme was designed as per the views and ideas of Honourable Chairman- Shri Prabhakar Desai; CEO of DSPM-CA Prasad Limaye and Principal-Dr Anuradha Ranade. The programme proved instrumental in raising the awareness of students regarding ragging-prohibition, prevention and punishment.

I thank all Heads of different departments and teachers for their active participation and co-operation for the organization of this programme. I also thank Dr Nandini Velhankar and Prof Kishor Phalak for their presence in the programme and whole-hearted support.
